TOOLBOX TALK 6 – Electrical Safety: Qualified vs. Unqualified

Key Points

- Only qualified workers may work on energized systems.
- Always de-energize and apply LOTO.
- Use insulated tools and voltage-rated PPE.

Expanded Talking Script

"Electricity doesn't give second chances. If you're not qualified—trained, tested, and authorized—you must stay clear of energized work. Even qualified workers must follow strict procedures."
